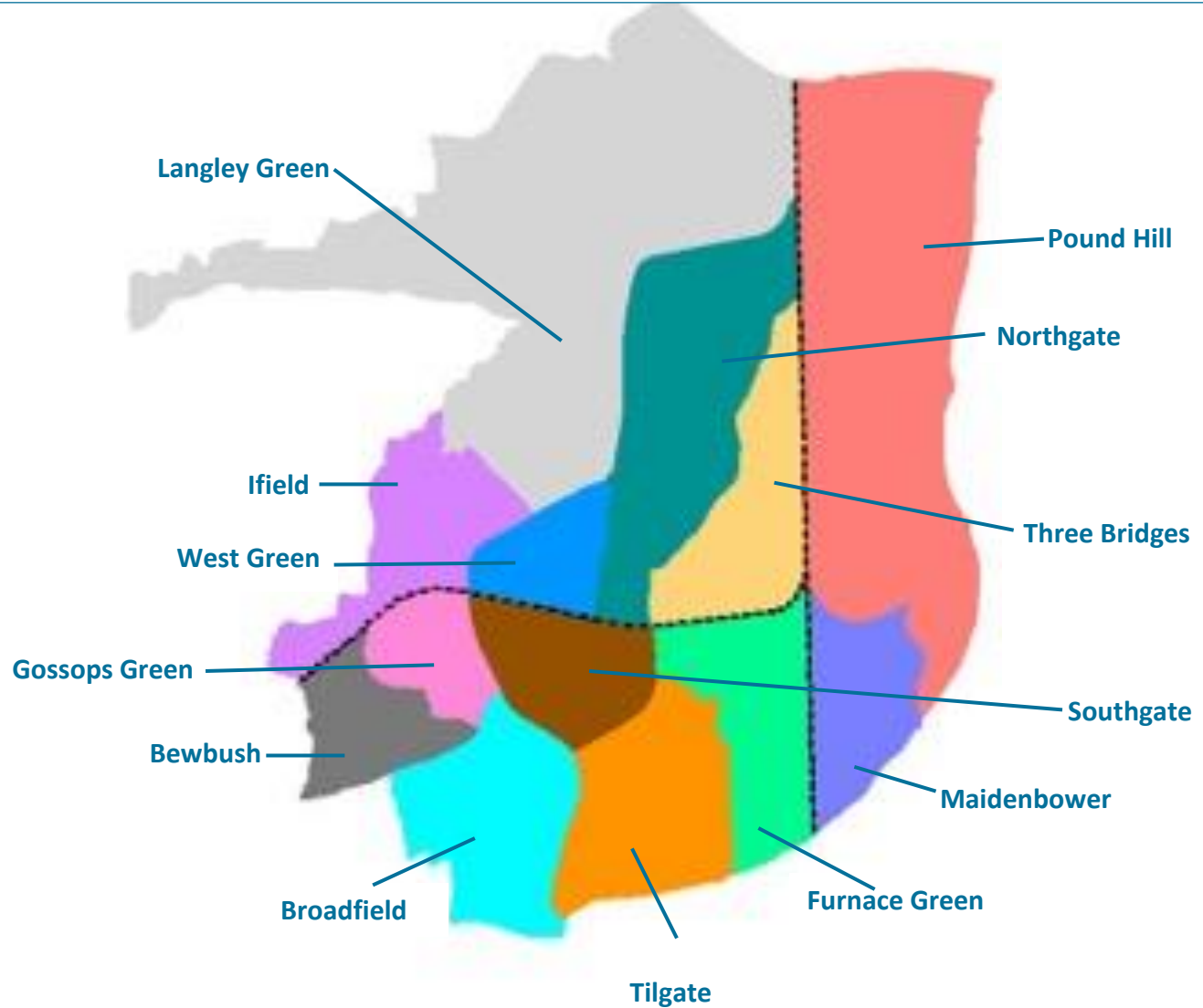

The members of the group repair and refresh old furniture so that it can be used again. Volunteers need to be patient, positive and encouraging, with good carpentry and craft skills.
